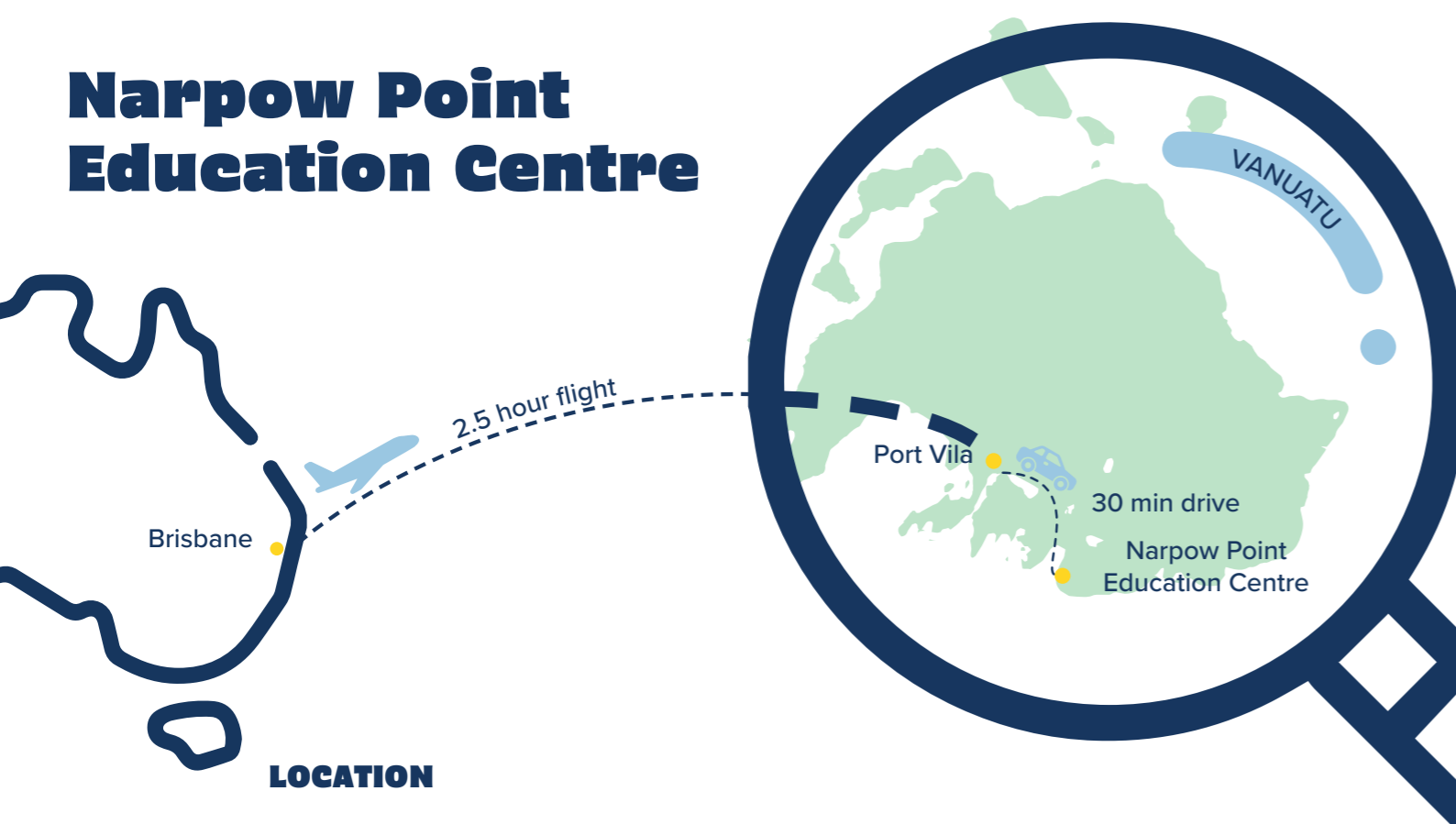
### **NARPOW POINT EDUCATION CENTRE**

At Redlands College we believe that learning should be characterised by joy, delight, curiosity, creativity and imagination. We also believe learning occurs best in community, facilitated by intentional relationships with fellow students, teachers, parents and community partners, that challenge each person to strive for excellence. To facilitate this philosophy of learning, we have developed the Narpow Point Education Centre, as a residential service learning program that is a capstone experience for our Year 9 students. Through service to others, students develop the foundational attributes of not only the Christian faith, but also a life grounded in Christ-reflecting character and values. Strength of character equips students to develop resilience and an appreciation of the beauty of the world around us, both of which are essential for their ongoing participation in a flourishing life.

The Education centre will be available for use by other organisations for approximately 6 months of the year. We invite you to consider this centre as an opportunity to enhance your educational goals.

# Narpow Point Education Centre



## LOCATION

Narpow Point Education Centre is a 30 minute drive South-East of Port Vila, the largest city in Vanuatu. It is situated on the beautiful Teouma bay. Port Vila is a two and a half hour flight from Brisbane.

## FACILITIES

- 1 acre property with a 40 metre ocean frontage.
- Two new dormitory buildings constructed in 2022.
- 3-bedroom house with a large veranda that serves as a kitchen, dining, and gathering area.
- A smaller dormitory with two toilets and two outdoor showers which sleeps four people.
- A grassy playing area with plenty of shade and fruit trees scattered around. Coconuts, pawpaws, and bananas are plentiful here.



2 x Dormitories  
3 rooms in each dormitory



Each room sleeps 8 people



Each room has its own toilet, shower and vanity

## PROGRAMS

Redlands College will primarily use the site for its “Project Vila” camps. These camps are a 2-week program that aims to support students’ preparation for Senior School.

Other programs operated by the College on the site include mission trips, leadership development camps, retreats, Duke of Ed expeditions, and Marine Biology excursions.

The site can host a wide variety of programs; other users can have the camps facilitated by on-site staff or run their own programs.



## COSTS



\$60 per person, per day transport (\$15), food (\$20), accommodation (\$25) and use of onsite equipment.

The cost of running a facilitated pre-arranged program can be negotiated and tailor made to suit the user.

## CAPACITY

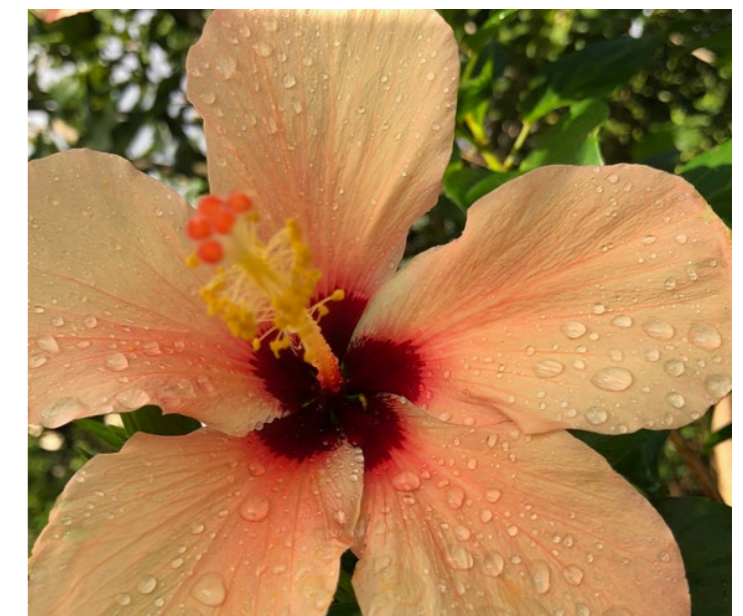


40 People
