ROAD SAFETY WEEK 22nd – 28th August 2022

Road Safety starts with me:

- A little courtesy on the road goes a long way to improving safety, whether you're on 2 wheels, 4 or more, or on 2 legs we are all responsible for keeping each other and ourselves safe on the road.
- When you are behind the wheel, driving safely should be the number one priority. You might be surprised to know that dangerous habits like tailgating, not giving way and running red lights, contribute to half of all serious crashes in Queensland.
- When approaching a roundabout, you must give way to all vehicles already on the roundabout.
- When the speed limit is 60km/h or under, motorists must leave a gap of at least 1 metre between their vehicle and bicycle riders when passing. When the speed limit is over 60km/h the gap must be at least 1.5 metres.
- Your keys to driving in Queensland publication is the road rules handbook for all drivers, including learner drivers. It contains essential information about the Queensland driver licensing system and road rules.
